



## Hotel Schlössle

Nestled in the heart of Tallinn's Old Town, Schlössle is the first Estonian five-star hotel, and the only hotel in the country that belongs to the Leading Hotels of the World chain. It is a phrase that equates to elegance, luxury and the highest quality.

## Hotel St. Petersburg

The St. Petersburg Hotel is a luxurious 4-star hotel in Tallinn's Old Town. In a building on Rataskaevu Street, built in the style of Russian traders, luxury, elegance and Russian cuisine come together. In the course of renovations of the boutique hotel, which boasts an excellent location in the heart of the Old Town, its historic architecture was fully preserved. The hotel welcomes guests with friendly and helpful staff.

The history of the building at Rataskaevu 7 dates back to the 14th century – it was mentioned for the first time in 1373. In 1850 the hotel was redesigned by prestigious architect Christian August Gabler, which makes the St. Petersburg the oldest operating hotel in Tallinn, Estonia.

The hotel was not left untouched by the revolutionary times that affected Estonia in the 1940s. On 22 November 1940 the Soviet Union nationalized the hotel. During the Soviet era the hotel was in the possession of the government and was used to accommodate government officials – including Soviet party leader and head of state Leonid Brezhnev. The building bore the name 'Hotel Rataskaevu' at the time.

The oldest hotel in Estonia, it was renovated in 1999 and renamed the 'St. Petersburg'. The hotel gained its current appearance during the renovations that began in 2013 and were completed in early 2014, when the hotel's interior design was thoroughly renewed by renowned British interior design agency Andrew Martin.



Baltic amber is fossilized pine (*Pinus succinifera*) resin, which has been affected by microorganisms, oxidation and other processes. Amber can be found in a variety of different shapes and sizes. Raw amber has a thin outer crust, which must be polished away in order to show the true beauty and colour of the stone.

Virginija and Kazimieras Mizgiris' are proud owners of amber galleries located in Vilnius and Nida. Visitors can see on display the history of Baltic amber, its formation, morphology, colours, and inclusions in a creative and original way. It locates a collection of amber, fossil resin and copal from all over the world not to mention an impressive collection of animal and plant inclusions. One of the exhibit is officially the largest marine amber in Lithuania weighting up to 3.8 kg. Visitors can touch pieces and feel the energy and warmth of 50- million-year-old amber. Everyone is welcome to use one of their senses and taste amber drink - "Amber Bitters".

Amber processing workshops are held for tourist groups and individuals in English, German and Russian. In these workshops one can see ancient and modern amber processing tools and learn the secrets of amber gathering. Tourists can process amber themselves, choosing a piece of raw amber to make into an amulet to bring luck.

Along with ancient amber artifacts, there are displays of amber jewellery crafted by prominent Lithuanian artists for visitors to purchase. All items are sold with certificates of authenticity, guaranteeing they are made of natural Baltic amber.





## Kukšu Muiža

Kukšu Manor house has an impressive history dating back to the days of Walter von Plettenberg, Master of the Livonian Order and one of the greatest leaders of the Teutonic Knights. The house that stands today was built in 1725. After a nearly five year long restoration works on 2006 Kukšu Manor house opened the doors to welcome its guests. Now it is considered a prime example of manor architecture in Latvia. Kukšu Manor house is located in deep in the heartland of Latvia, overlooking a small lake in the woods.

Ornate carpeting, sparkling chandeliers, antique furnishings and paintings will bring you into the unique world of the Kukšu Manor. 13 elegant bedrooms in the manor house have been attentively refurbished to elicit a particular atmosphere.
